

Remove all the impediments.


Enforce the scrum ceremonies and processes.

Centre of gravity for sprint scope and success.

Commit to goals and deadlines on behalf of the team.

# Product Owner

---

- Convey the vision of stakeholder(s) to the team
  - Authority to alter the scope
  - Responsible for ROI
  - Voice of stakeholder
  - Priorities backlog for the team
  - Communicate progress/problem to the stakeholder

# Scrum Team

---

Responsible for working towards meeting sprint goals

Works with Scrum Master to choose priority items from the Product backlog in sprint planning

Team must ensure that they can deliver the agreed/committed results on time with quality

Self-organized

Attend daily standup and other ceremonies

Participate retrospective meetings. Ensure that the findings are practically addressed.

# The Stakeholders

Convey their wishes and concerns clearly to the Product Owner

Provide regular input to queries from Product Owner

Prioritize work affectively with product owner

Regularly update if there is any change in plan
